#### WHO IS JESUS

#### Bible Study Number 1

A Denver woman told her pastor of a recent experience that she felt was a sign of the times. She'd walked into a jewelry store looking for a necklace. "I'd like a gold cross," she said. The man behind the counter looked over the stock in the display case and said, "Do you want a plain one, or one with a little man on it?"

Wow!... There sure is a lot of misunderstanding about the Person of Christ today, isn't there? You'll hear all sorts of theories and explanations as to who this Person is. Some groups even claim He was just a good man or a prophet, others say He was "the archangel Michael" and incredibly still others claim He was "a god among many gods," the brother of the angel Lucifer before He became Satan.

To be sure, Jesus is unique. There has never been anyone like Him in the history of the world! Our calendars are even based on His birth. (B.C. meaning, Before Christ). As one writer aptly said about Jesus, "We stand far from the mark when we say that all the armies that have ever marched, all the navies that have been built and sailed, all the parliaments that have ever sat and all the kings that have ever reigned put together have not affected the life of man upon this earth as has that one solitary life.

Because of these things, the most important question you can ask yourself is this, "Who is Jesus?" Your life will be affected for all eternity by the way you answer that question! And that's what this lesson is all about, the identity of Jesus Christ. Before beginning, pause for a moment and ask God to help you learn the truth about Jesus from His Word.

### JESUS HAS THE NATURE OF MAN!

It's important to note that Jesus did not have a button on His back that He would press to make Him God or man. He is 100% God and 100% man at the same time! He voluntarily submitted to His Father when His "God attributes" would be in operation.

His humanity (human nature) is revealed to us in many ways. He became hungry, thirsty, and sometimes did not even know who touched Him! God certainly cannot fall asleep, yet Jesus did. God cannot die, yet Jesus did. God needed to become a man in order to suffer and die for us.
