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**COMMON AREA LANDSCAPING UPDATE**

**[BrightView Report - June 17](#)**

This week, crews were busy blowing and removing debris, making irrigation repairs, mowing and fertilizing grass, cutting back plants, spraying and removing weeds, and inspecting the health of plants and trees in the **Mesquite Highlands, Saguaro Highlands, The Links, Fairways, Horizon, Palazzo, Mirador, Medina, and Stone Canyon** neighborhoods.



Crews also sprayed and removed weeds along **Westar Drive** and in the **Golf Canyon** and **Golf Ridge** neighborhoods. Pre-emergent was applied in common areas of **Lucero**, on **Estrella Parkway**, and **Calistoga Drive**.

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## **FACILITIES PROJECT REPORT**

### **LAKE FISH RESTOCKING**

Both North and South Lakes were restocked with fish this week. 1,500 Red Ear Sunfish were introduced and are great for bug control and catch-and-release fishing. 4,500 Large Goldfish were also added and will assist in controlling the midge fly population.

### **PALM TREE TRIMMING PROJECT**

On Monday, June 22, teams from BrightView will begin trimming the palm trees around Starpointe Residents Club and North and South Lakes. This project will take several weeks to complete.

### **PLAYGROUND RESURFACING PROJECT**

The play structure in the **Sonoran Springs** playground is scheduled to be resurfaced on Friday, June 26. Please stay off the play structure until the caution tape has been removed and the surface is ready for play.

### **NORTH LAKE IRRIGATION UPGRADE PROJECT**

The North Lake irrigation upgrade project continues this week. Crews are installing new

irrigation pipes, valves, rotors, and sprinkler heads throughout the turf area surrounding North Lake. This project is expected to last three months.

### **NORTH LAKE FOUNTAINS**

One fountain in North Lake is out of service due to a needed repair on the pump. The pump is being serviced at this time and will be brought back on-site once the repair is complete.
