Landscape Update

This week, crews were busy making irrigation repairs, trimming trees and shrubs, mowing turf, removing weeds and inspecting the health of plants and trees in the **Trailridge Crossing**,

Avalon Terrace, Privada, Eagle Pointe, La Entrada, Avalon del Lago, Overlook, Desert Vista, Reflection Bay and Cielo neighborhoods, and in the common area along Westar Drive and Calistoga Drive. Crews are also applying weed pre-emergent throughout neighborhoods in the community.

The BrightView team also made irrigation repairs in Lucero and on Elliot Road and are in the process of preparing turf around the community for overseeding.

COMMUNITY PAINTING PROJECT

Teams from AllStar Pro began painting the culvert guardrails along Estrella Parkway this week. This project will be underway for several weeks.

PLAYGROUND MAINTENANCE

The outside maintenance team tilled the woodchips in 15 neighborhood playgrounds this week including **Mesquite Highlands, Greenspointe, and The Links.**

SOUTH LAKE LANDSCAPE ENHANCEMENTS

Crews began working around South Lake near Reflection Bay this week to enhance portions of the landscape by installing concrete curbing, new granite, plants, and turf. This project will be take place over the next several weeks.

FIRE HYDRANT MAINTENANCE

Beginning **Monday, September 21**, the city of Goodyear will begin the maintenance of fire hydrants. Goodyear has contracted with Hydra Contracting to flush and pressure test all fire hydrants associated with the water distribution system. Form a Neighborhood Watch

The Goodyear Police Department would like to see residents get involved in helping keep their neighborhoods safe. One key way to accomplish this is to have a [Neighborhood Watch Program](#) in your Estrella neighborhood. Neighborhood Watch is a program where your neighborhood takes an active role in crime prevention and community development.

The responsibilities of a Neighborhood Watch Captain or Co-Captain include:

- Acting as liaison between the neighborhood and the Police Department
- Getting to know the neighbors in your community
- Coordinating periodic meetings with the Neighborhood Watch Group to discuss problems and assistance requirements
- Reporting issues and concerns (e.g., suspicious persons, places or vehicles) to the Goodyear Police Department

The Neighborhood Watch Program draws upon the compassion of average citizens, asking them to lend their neighbors a hand. It is important for your watch group to record those efforts and assist the Goodyear Police Department by registering your group.
