
SOUTH LAKE ENHACEMENTS: This week, crews continued the installation of granite for the enhancement project. We expect the enhancements to be complete by the first week of December.

Want to be the Most "Poop-ular" Pet Owner in Estrella? Please Pick Up After Your Pet

Estrella is a beautiful community in which to live, both for humans and their furry companions. Now that the weather has cooled down, we love seeing our residents out and about with their pets! Of course, owning a pet does come with extra responsibility, both inside and outside of your home. Here are some quick reminders to help you, your pet and your neighbors enjoy Estrella:

Pets should not be left alone in any common area space and are not allowed in playground areas or on playground equipment. Similarly, pets must be on a standard (not retractable) leash, no longer than six feet in length and under owner control at all times when they are in our parks and common areas. These open spaces are for children, adults, and families to play and safely enjoy time outdoors.

It is also important to remember that not all people are animal lovers and larger pets, regardless of how friendly they are, can easily overwhelm a child or a person who is uneasy around animals. The best bet is to ask before you approach someone with your dog -- even if it is on a leash.

Finally, please remember how important it is to pick up after your pet. The Association has installed -- and stocks -- multiple pet waste stations around the community to help ensure ease of access to a container and receptacle. Please be respectful of your neighbors by disposing of your dog's waste. Thank you!

The More You Know: Full Moon Hike on Monday

Join the Estrella Trailblazers for a Full Moon Hike on Monday, November 30

Hikers will meet at the F.I.N.S. parking area at 5:00 p.m. and hike up the hills in daylight until about 5:20 p.m. The full moon is expected to make an appearance from behind the Sierra Estrella Mountains after the sun goes down. Total hiking distance will be about 2.25 miles and hikers will return to the parking area at approximately 6:45 p.m.



"I've said this before, you have not seen Estrella until you see it from an elevation by the light of the full moon," said Estrella Trailblazer Fred Wordell. "Let's keep positive thoughts directed at continued clear evening skies!"

Face masks will be mandatory and parents will have to maintain their familial group with them. Flashlights or headlamps are recommended, as is water. 
Weekend Bridge Closures on Tuthill Road Continue

The Maricopa County Department of Transportation (MCDOT) will close the bridge on Tuthill Road over the Gila River for several weekends. Crews are repairing bridge decks, approach slabs, barrier walls, and will apply an epoxy overlay to the bridge deck surface. The maintenance work will impact travel in the area and MCDOT is asking residents to allow extra time for detours, as well as to please obey traffic control signs and slow down in the work zone.

Closure Schedule:

Please be prepared for 24-hour full closure from Friday at 9:00 a.m. through Monday at 5:00 a.m., on the following weekends:

- December 11 December 14
- December 18 December 21
- January 8 January 11



The Bridge will be open for travel Monday-Thursday and there will be no closures on holiday weekends.
