Community Projects

TURF COLORANT PROJECT: Next week, BrightView teams will begin applying non-toxic and environmentally friendly turf colorant to the lawns surrounding the Starpointe Residents Club, the Ampitheatre at North Lake and around the Yacht Club. To prevent transfer of the dye to shoes and furry paws, please stay off the lawn and keep to the sidewalks and walkways. The length of this project relies on the cooperation of the weather and is expected to last several weeks.



PLANT INSTALLATION PROJECT: BrightView teams are in the process of installing plants and shrubs to enhance the entryways of 38 neighborhoods. Plants have been installed at the entryways of **Legends, Mesquite Ridge, Sonoran Springs, Saguaro Canyon, Saguaro Summit, Sonoran Vistas, Avalon, Desert Vista, The Palisades, Parkside, Lakeview, Spanish Bay, Oasis, Avalon Del Lago, Cielo, Trailridge Crossing, Emerald Greens, Eagle Pointe, Fairways and Eagle Ridge.**

STREET SWEEPING: The following neighborhoods are scheduled for street sweeping on Wednesday, December 9: **Emerald Greens, The Enclaves, Golf Canyon, The Fairways, Golf Ridge, Golf Villas, Hidden Hills, The Palisades, Sonoran Vistas and Reflection Bay.**

LADERA PARK: Ground is being broken this week on Ladera Park. Grading will start this month; components for the park features are currently being manufactured. When completed, this new community amenity will include a splash pad, play equipment, lawn area, comfort station and picnic area. The park is expected to be open at the end of 2021.

STAR TOWER WATERFALL CLEANING PROJECT: The rocks for the Star Tower waterfall were pressure washed this week and the cattails were removed as part of a preventative maintenance program.

Community Handbook Updated!

The Estrella Community Handbook was updated and approved by the Board of Directors at its December 1 meeting. Updates include:

Common Area Usage: The Common Areas including the ramadas, athletic courts and play equipment should be used only for the purpose for which they are intended. The common areas cannot be used in any advertised, commercial, non-profit or for-profit capacity and cannot be privately used for the exchange of any money, goods or services. Additionally, special events held on the common area property must have prior written approval.

Estrella Flag Policy: In addition to displaying the American flag, First Responder flags with a colored stripe as depicted in the images below may also be displayed when approved by the DRC. Flags must be of a reasonable size as determined by the DRC and maintained in good condition in accordance with community standards; the American flag must be flown in accordance with the Federal Flag Code.

The holiday season has started in Estrella!


