

#### WATER METER REPLACEMENTS

The city of Goodyear is working with its contractor, Metering Services, Inc., to replace old water meters across the city. The work is scheduled to begin on

January 11, 2021.

Residents with water meters identified for replacement will receive notification in the mail prior to the replacement. The water meter replacement process at each home will take less than an hour and requires a short water disruption of about 10-15 minutes. Work will take place only at the water meter location and does not require access to other areas of the property or home. Prior to switching over the meter and shutting off water for a brief period, the workers will notify the resident by knocking on their door.

### The More You Know... Arizona Fun Facts

Yes, we know it's hot. And that it's a dry heat (and that it's still hot, regardless). But did you also know these fun weather and geology facts about the state you call home?

 Arizona has 3,928 mountain peaks and summits -- more mountains than any one of the other Mountain States (Colorado, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, New Mexico, Utah, and Wyoming).



- Arizona has 26 peaks that are more than 10,000 feet in elevation.
- Arizona's disparate climate can yield both the highest temperature across the nation and the lowest temperature across the nation *on the same day*.

- Rainfall averages for Arizona range from less than three inches in the deserts to more than 30 inches per year in the mountains.
- The cactus wren is the official state bird. It gets its name from the fact that it likes to build nests in the protection of thorny desert plants, like the saguaro cactus (pictured above).
