This week, crews were busy making irrigation repairs, trimming trees and shrubs, removing weeds and inspecting the health of plants and trees in the neighborhoods of **Trailridge Crossing, Avalon Terrace, Privada, Eagle Ridge, La Entrada, the San Miguel Right-of-Way, the Westar Right-of-Way from San Miguel to Parcel 5.5, Avalon Del Lago, Overlook, Cielo** and the length of **Hillside Drive** in **Lucero**.

Crews also removed dead palms at both North and South Lake this week. They are scheduled to begin refurbishing

the pavers at South Lake next week.

The Great Backyard Bird Count

Each February, for four days, the world comes together for the love of birds. This year, Estrella residents can join bird watchers around the world by joining the Great Backyard Bird Count, which will take place between February 12-15.

Participating is easy, fun to do, and can be done anywhere you find birds in Estrella. Simply watch birds for 15 minutes or more at least once between February 12-15, 2021. The observations you share will help scientists at the Cornell Lab of Ornithology, National Audubon Society, and Birds Canada better understand global bird populations before one of their annual migrations.
