This week, crews were busy making irrigation repairs, trimming trees and shrubs, removing weeds and inspecting the health of plants and trees in the La Mirada, Las Palmas, Valencia, Serenity, Golf Canyon, Golf Ridge, Inspire, Greenspointe and Ironwood Pointe neighborhoods.



Crews also installed plants and trees along the **South Lake Breezeway**, pictured above.

Additionally, weeds have been sprayed along the Estrella Parkway, San Miguel, Westar and Willis Right-of-Ways, and throughout the neighborhoods of Sonoran Springs and Saguaro Canyon.



**March 23 Board Meeting Summary** 

The **ECA**, **VCA** and **EJC** Boards of Directors held virtual Board Meetings on Tuesday, March 23, at 6:30 p.m. The following topics, among others, were discussed:

 Wall painting was approved by the VCA Board for the following neighborhoods: Saguaro Highlands, Eagle Ridge, Privada, Emerald Greens, The Fairways, and The Links.



- The EJC Board approved granite replenishment for the Las Palmas, Stone Canyon, Valencia,
  Serenity and Arroyo Vista / Ridgepoint View neighborhoods.
- The EJC Board approved the proposed relocation of the Yacht Club sign on Estrella Parkway to provide more visibility for pedestrian traffic when drivers pull out of the parking lot.

We are working with our project contractors on scheduling the painting and granite replenishment projects and will update residents in the weekly newsletters when start dates are confirmed.
