## **IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT**

Dear Residents,

In response to Governor Ducey's <u>Executive Order 2021-06</u>, the Board of Directors has made the following updates to Estrella's COVID Guidelines. These changes go into effect immediately.

- The wearing of masks in the Residents Clubs, Fitness Centers and Aerobics Rooms is strongly recommended, but no longer required.
- Temperature checks at the Resident Club entrances are strongly recommended, but no longer required.

The following protocols remain in place:

- Social distancing: certain machines in the Fitness Centers will remain closed to allow for social distancing. Please avoid congregating in the Clubs and Fitness Centers so social distance requirements can be met.
- Sanitizing equipment will continue: residents are required to sanitize equipment

before and after use while in the Fitness Rooms.

- Community Services Office and Resident Club Team Members are still required to wear masks and practice social distancing.
- The Pre-Schooner and Youth Club remain closed at this time.
- The Community Services Office is open by appointment only.

We continue to encourage residents to follow social distancing recommendations in the community and common areas. Please note that any amenities you use or areas you visit are at your own risk. If you or someone in your household is ill or exhibiting any symptoms of illness, please remain at home and refrain from using amenities.

We recognize that residents are operating at different comfort levels related to our state and community reopening and ask that you please be kind and considerate to all neighbors during this time.
