## Friday Community Operations Update



This week, crews were busy making irrigation repairs, trimming trees and shrubs, mowing lawns, removing weeds and inspecting the health of plants and trees in the **Palazzo, Mirador, Medina, Stone Canyon, Stone Gate, Córdoba, Saronno, Mesquite Highlands, Saguaro Highlands** and **The Links** neighborhoods.

Additionally, BrightView has begun the **Hardwood and Palm Tree Trimming Projects**. The crews have been working in **Golf Canyon** this week; a photo of one of the trees pruned in this neighborhood is pictured at left. Next week, the crews will begin pruning trees in **Golf Ridge**.

Crews will then move on to the following neighborhoods:

1. **Fairways:** May 21-June 4
2. **Mesquite Highlands:** June 7-8
3. **Sonoran Highlands:** June 9-10
4. **Ironwood Pointe:** June 11-21
5. **La Entrada:** June 22-24
6. **La Mirada:** June 25-July 2
7. **Serenity:** July 3-11

## Community Projects



The **Granite Replenishment Project** is complete in **Las Palmas** and **Valencia**. Crews have started working in the **Serenity** neighborhood and will begin working in **Stone Canyon** the week of May 24. Granite replenishment will begin in the **Arroyo Vista** and **Ridgeview Point** neighborhoods when work in Stone Canyon is complete.

The **VCA Wall Refurbishment Project** continues. The painters will begin painting view fences in **Eagle Ridge** starting **Monday, May 24**, and in **Privada** starting **Monday, May 31**; they will start placing door hangers with additional information about this phase of the project next week. To prepare for view fence painting, **Eagle Ridge** and **Privada** residents are requested to:



- Please keep pets indoors while the painters are working on your view fence;
- Please remove lights on, and furniture near, your view fence; and
- Please have your landscaping trimmed back away from your view fence.

This ongoing project will continue over the next several months in the **Emerald Greens**, **Saguaro Highlands**, **The Fairways** and **The Links** neighborhoods.

# The More You Know: StarSplash Waterpark Opens on May 22!

The water slides at the StarSplash Waterpark will officially open at **11:00 a.m. on Saturday, May 22**, and will be open seven days a week through August 1:

- **Monday-Friday: 11:00 a.m.-8:00 p.m.**
- **Saturday-Sunday: 11:00 a.m.-6:30 p.m.**

Below are a few reminders to ensure everyone enjoys their time at the pools and waterpark this summer:

### Guest Passes

- Any unused guest passes from 2020 have been rolled over into a household's 2021 allotment.
- When all free guest passes have been utilized, additional guest passes can be purchased at the front desks at both the Starpointe and Presidio Residents Clubs.
  - Daily passes cost \$5 per day, per guest.
  - A weekly discount card costs \$15, and is valid for seven consecutive days.
  - Guest fees apply to all guests aged four and up.
- Guest forms must be completed **in person** at the front desks at Starpointe and Presidio by the owner/lessee.
- Households may bring up to four guests per day to the Starpointe or Presidio swimming pools, waterpark and splash pad.

### Pool/Amenity Usage

- Young children still in diapers must wear the required inner disposable AND outer reusable swim diapers. Both items are available for purchase at Starpointe and Presidio. The disposable diaper costs \$1.00 and the reusable diaper costs \$15.00.
- Residents may bring coolers with light snacks and non-alcoholic beverages to the pool area.
- Commercial food items purchased from outside establishments cannot be brought into the Starpointe or Presidio Residents Clubs or to the pool areas.
- Glass containers are prohibited.
