



Friday Community Operations Update



This week, crews were busy making irrigation repairs, trimming trees and shrubs, mowing lawns, removing weeds and inspecting the health of plants and trees in both Lucero and along Hillside Drive in that neighborhood (pictured left), as well as in Sonoran Vistas, Sonoran Springs, Ridgeview Point and Mesquite Ridge. Spray techs continue to spray pre- and post- emergent in Lucero, as well.

The Hardwood and Palm Tree Trimming Projects continue with crews slated to finish work in **The Fairways** next week. Once hardwood tree trimming in this neighborhood is complete, crews will move on to **Mesquite Highlands** (June 7-8); **Saguaro Highlands** (June 9-10); **Ironwood**

Pointe (June 11-21); La Entrada (June 22-24); La Mirada (June 25-July 2); and Serenity (July 3-11).

VCA Wall Refurbishment

Granite Replenishment

BrightView crews replenished granite in **Stone Canyon** this week and are scheduled to work in the **Arroyo**

Vista and Ridgeview Point neighborhoods next week. Granite replenishment in the Las Palmas, Valencia and Serenity neighborhoods is complete.



City of Goodyear Water Main

Replacement Project

On Tuesday, June 1, a consultant from the City of Goodyear will be onsite in the **Cordero** neighborhood determining the locations of key underground utilities for the City's <u>Water Main Replacement Project</u>. This

project includes installation of new infrastructure for the water system, which is scheduled to begin in July of 2022.

Next week, engineers will dig several small test holes, which will block one lane of roadway. These holes will then be patched to return the surface to its original condition. The work is expected to be completed in the same week and vehicles and pedestrians will have access to Cordero throughout this portion of the project. The information gathered during these tests will be used to finalize plans for the pipeline installation next year.
