Friday Community Operations Update



This week, crews were busy making irrigation repairs, trimming trees and shrubs, removing weeds and inspecting the health of plants and trees along the Calistoga Right-of-Way and in the following neighborhoods: Ironwood Pointe, Greenspointe, The Links, Las Palmas, La Mirada, Valencia, and Serenity.

Spray techs continue to inspect and spray weeds in the community. This week, crews sprayed weeds throughout common areas in **Lucero**.

As a reminder, BrightView has turned the water off in turf areas that will be overseeded this year, which is why turf has started turning brown. Crews began scalping turf this week and will begin the overseeding process next week.

Developer Update

The EMR ownership has applied to the City of Goodyear to amend the Goodyear 2025 General Plan Land Use and Transportation Map for approximately 420 acres at the northeast corner of Willis Road and Estrella Parkway. The amendment is to update the General Plan for this area from the "Business & Commerce" category to the "Neighborhoods" category.



If the General Plan amendment is approved, then there would be approximately 40 acres of land within the "Business & Commerce" category at this intersection. We invite you to attend a Neighborhood Meeting on this General Plan Map change next **Wednesday**, **September 29**, **2021**, at **6:30 p.m.** at the Starpointe Residents Club, 17665 W. Elliot Rd, Goodyear AZ 85338.

Community Project Round-Up

Several projects will be taking place over the next several weeks in both Estrella's neighborhoods and at the community's amenities. VCA Wall Refurbishment Project Walls in Saguaro Summit, Ridgeview/ Arroyo and Ridgeview Point will be refurbished in October and November.

Seal Coating Project

Streets in The Fairways, Emerald Greens, Sonoran Vistas and Hidden Hills will be seal coated in October, as will the parking lots at Bougainvillea Park, South Lake Park and the Presidio Residents Club.



Neighborhood Enhancement Project

The entrance to the Montecito neighborhood will be enhanced with new trees and plants in October.

Paver Refurbishment Project

Brick pavers around North Lake will be refurbished with polymeric sand next month.
