This week, crews were busy making irrigation repairs, trimming trees and shrubs, removing weeds and inspecting the health of plants and trees in Arroyo Vista, Legends, Avalon, The Highlands, Trailridge, Desert Breeze, Emerald Greens and Eagle Ridge.

While BrightView crews are prepping several areas in the community for new winter seed, Rye grass is starting to come up in various neighborhoods. Signs have been installed in areas that have been overseeded advising residents to stay on sidewalks and paths. Thank you for helping to ensure the new turf continues to thrive and grow!

## **Community Projects**

#### **VCA Wall Refurbishment Project**

Work continues in **Saguaro Summit**; stucco repairs are now in progress and will need to cure for 10-14 days. Metal painting work is slated to begin next week. For this portion of the project, residents are requested to:

- Please keep pets indoors while the painters are working on your view fence;
- Please remove lights on, and furniture near, your view fence;
- Please have your landscaping trimmed back away from your view fence.



Pressure washing and prep work is now complete in **Ridgeview/Arroyo** and the application of Drylock has begun.



# **Neighborhood Maintenance**

Our team ran new wire for the ground lights at the **Hidden Hills** monument sign. Yellow curbing paint was refreshed, as well.

#### **Asphalt Repairs**

Our contractor completed the crack fill and re-sealing project in **Emerald Greens**. Work on this project will continue through the end of the month in **The Fairways**.

Roads in Hidden Hills and Sonoran Vistas are

scheduled for these repairs between
October 26 and 28. The parking lots at
the Presidio Residents Club, South Lake
Park, and Bougainvillea Park are slated for
crack-fill and resealing on October 27 and 28.






# **Lake Fogging**
