The interior turf areas of the **Reflection Bay** neighborhood and the areas surrounding South Lake will be treated for midge flies **after 10:00 p.m.** on the evening of **Friday November 12**. Residents are requested to stay away from these areas during treatment; those with lakeside homes should close windows and doors, and keep pets indoors during this time.
