This week, crews were busy making irrigation repairs, trimming trees and shrubs, removing weeds and inspecting the health of plants and trees in the following neighborhoods: Palazzo, Mirador, Medina, Stone Canyon, Stone Gate, Saronno, Cordoba, Vidrio, Mission Hermosa, The Fairways, Mesquite Highlands and Saguaro Highlands.

BrightView teams have been applying a non-toxic and environmentally friendly turf colorant to the lawns south of Estrella Parkway, around the North Lake Amphitheater and the Starpointe Residents Club. Please observe posted

signage to keep to the sidewalks and walkways to prevent transfer of the dye to shoes and pets' paws.

BrightView crews have completed the installation of winter plants in the following neighborhoods: Desert Vista, Cielo, The Highlands, Trailridge, Desert Breeze, Trailridge Crossing, Avalon Terrace, Privada, Eagle Pointe, Eagle Ridge, Saguaro Highlands, Mesquite Highlands, La Entrada, La Mirada, Las Palmas, Valencia and Serenity.

The tree replacement project has been completed in the following neighborhoods: **Mesquite Highlands La Mirada, Las Palmas, Valencia ,Serenity, Tranquillity, Palazzo,** 

### Mirador, Medina, Stone Canyon, Saronno Cordoba and Mission Hermosa.

Spray technicians continue to spray weeds throughout Estrella and maintenance crews and spray techs are removing and spraying weeds in the common areas.

There are three open seats in the March 2022 election and residents who are elected will serve on the VCA Board with two developer-appointed Board Members until the September 2022 Annual Meeting.


