The ABCs of ATV Use in Estrella

Now that the temperatures are starting to climb (can you beat 70 degrees during an Arizona winter?), many of our residents are out enjoying the time they spend in the community's common areas, on our walking and hiking trails, in their backyards, as well as in vehicles other than their traditional cars or trucks.

While ATVs help drivers and their passengers feel even closer to their surroundings, they do leave a lot of noise, dust and debris in their wake, which affects the time residents spend in *their* outdoor spaces.

When you are out enjoying Estrella's beautiful surroundings and Arizona's amazing weather, please keep these ABCs of ATV use in mind...



- Always be mindful of where you can and cannot drive motorized vehicles. ATVs, UTVs, motorcycles, scooters, go-carts and similar vehicles cannot enter, drive upon or through any vacant parcel, open space, wash and/or retention areas, tracts, common areas (including parks), bike paths, trails and walkways.
- **B**e considerate of your friends and neighbors. The noise, dust and debris motorized vehicles leave behind negatively impact the time residents spend in backyards that are adjacent to open areas.
