The VCA Nominating Committee is seeking **talented**, **community-minded VCA homeowners** with **innovative ideas** and a **desire to collaborate** to serve as members of the VCA Board in the March 2022 election. Interested residents should be **dedicated**, **proactive**, **positive** and **willing to serve until September of this year**.

As a member of the VCA Board of Directors, you will be responsible for upholding the governing documents of the Association, listening and making informed decisions in the best interest of the VCA, and communicating with other homeowners. Those who serve as Board Members often derive a lot of satisfaction from helping to make a great community even better!

There are three open seats in the March 2022 election and residents who are elected will serve on the VCA Board with two developer-appointed Board Members until the September 2022 Annual Meeting.

This is the second of three elections that will take place as the VCA transitions from a Developer-Controlled Board (where a majority of positions are held by Estrella's developer) to a Homeowner Board of Directors (where the majority of positions are held by residents of the Villages Community Association).

QR Codes

You may have noticed some pixelated squares on our communications lately. Ever wonder what they are and why we are using them?



Short for "Quick Response,"

QR Codes are barcodes or scannable patterns that are easily "read" by smart phones. They contain information like website links or even restaurant menus, and can be found on social media, advertisements, and in our Resident Engagement Area at the Starpointe Residents Club. While QR Codes have been around for some time now, they became increasingly popular during the pandemic because they are contactless. They are also more efficient than having to type in a long URL address to get where you want to go.


Gnome Kidding!
