Yellow curbing paint was refreshed in **Trailridge Crossing** and **The Fairways** this week.






Amenity Maintenance

The steps and platforms were recently refurbished at the **Trailridge Crossing** playground.






South Lake

The **Estrella Garden Committee** is seeking members who would like to participate in the Estrella Community Garden.


