Due to the high risk associated with pyrotechnics, please know that you will be redirected, and asked to turn around by City of Goodyear staff, including members of the Police Department, should you approach the fireworks staging area.

Also, please don't forget that the **Starpointe Residents Club and Parking Lot will close at noon** and the **Yacht Club will be closed all day** tomorrow, but the Presidio Residents Club will be open standard operating hours, which are 5:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.

While out enjoying our local bands, the Giant Games Gauntlet and meals from 10 food trucks, please remember that...

- Due to unpredictable -- and sometimes gusty -- winds, no umbrellas or shade tents may be erected on the event lawn
- Lawn seating is first-come, first-served
- Parking is limited; therefore, carpooling, walking or biking to North Lake is recommended
- There will be plenty of water, but no alcohol, at the event; please do not bring any alcoholic beverages to GLM Fest
- No glass may be brought into the event
- Pets -- with the exception of service animals -- are not allowed at the event

VCA Wall Refurbishment Project

The VCA Wall Refurbishment Project continues. In **Avalon del Lago**, painters are slated to begin painting walls and view fencing on Monday, April 11. They will begin power-washing and prepping perimeter walls and view fencing in Echo Ridge on Monday, as well.

Residents are requested to please **keep pets indoors** while the painters are working on your view fence; **remove lights** on, and furniture near, your view fence; and **trim landscaping** back away from your view fence.

South Lake Maintenance Projects

Our team worked on several projects around South Lake this week. The volleyball courts, horseshoe pits and surrounding sand was raked, and the stakes and fencing was painted. The sand at the playground was tilled and raked, and the Ramadas, walkways and playground equipment were power washed.





South Lake Restroom Refurbishment Project

Work on the South Lake Restroom continues. Temporary, portable ADA bathrooms and a mobile hand wash station are located near the sports courts for easy access and are scheduled to be cleaned on a twice-weekly basis.
